MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S POSITION:



Miami-Dade Legislative Item, adopted 7/10/2001, File Number: 011990

Section 8-40 PRODUCT APPROVALS. Any person desiring to use materials/products used for protection of the envelope of the structure, limited to windows, exterior glazing, wall cladding, roofing, exterior doors, skylights, glass block, siding and shutters shall obtain a high wind velocity zone approval from the Florida Building Commission or shall obtain a local approval from the Building Code Compliance Office.
